The programme was jointly conducted by the Cyber Police Station, Dhule and Maharashtra Knowledge Corporation Limited (MKCL), Dhule.

On this occasion, Mr. Tushar Warule, Marketing Consultant from MKCL, Dhule, was invited as the resource person. The programme was anchored by Prof. Krushna Bhalkar.

During the interactive session, Mr. Warule emphasized that in today's technological era, the use of digital technology has increased significantly not only in India but across the world. With smartphones now commonly used by every individual, online banking and digital payment systems have become widespread. He made students aware of various types of cyber frauds such as trading scams, "work from home" frauds, fake job offers, sextortion threats through video calls, impersonation of police officers or lawyers by sending fake legal notices, and frauds involving suspicious links or OTP sharing.

He also guided students, homemakers, businessmen, teenagers, senior citizens, and learners on the precautions to be taken while using mobile phones and the internet to prevent online frauds and reduce cybercrime. The session aimed at creating awareness and promoting safe digital practices among the participants.

Additionally, Mr. Warule provided information about various online courses offered by MKCL, especially in the field of computers, courses, including Database Management Fundamentals, Written Communication Skills, and Basic Robotics, among others.


